



### TOEFL REQUIREMENT FOR ADMISSION

All undergraduate applicants, regardless of citizenship, who have not attended schools at the secondary level or above for at least three years full time where English is the principal language of instruction must present a minimum score of 525 (paper based) or 195 computer based on the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language).

All graduate and post baccalaureate applicants, regardless of citizenship, who do not possess a bachelor's degree from a postsecondary institution where English is the principal language of instruction, must receive a minimum score of 550 on the TOEFL (computer based =213) for all graduate programs except for MBA and Urban & Regional Planning (580 minimum paper based or 237 minimum computer based score) and English (585 paper based or 238 computer based minimum score).

Cal Poly Pomona does not grant conditional admission pending a sufficient TOEFL score. There are no exceptions to the TOEFL requirement. Only the International TOEFL (not Institutional TOEFL) will be considered for admission. TOEFL scores older than two years cannot be accepted.
