## AUTO BURGLARIES

There have been a series of burglaries from vehicles parked in campus parking lots. Since October 20, three auto burglaries have occurred in the F Parking Lot, two in the Parking Structure, one at the University Village, and one at Regenerative Studies. Some of the stolen items include navigation system(s), DVD player(s), I-pod, a laptop computer and cash.

A burglary was likely prevented on October 29th, when an alert witness noticed suspicious activity; the suspect left the area when he noticed he was being watched.

University Police strongly urges campus community members to practice crime prevention measures and report any suspicious persons or activity right away. All valuables, such as briefcases, laptops, electronic devices, and mounting devices for electronic equipment should be removed from the vehicle or secured in the trunk. A mounting device left in view may be an indicator to the thief that the associated electronic device may be hidden in the vehicle (glove compartment). Consider using anti-theft devices, such as car alarm systems.

Report any suspicious activity in or around the area of parked vehicles by dialing (909) 869-3070 from a cell phone, or Dial 9-1-1 from a campus phone line or from a Code Blue 911 emergency tower in the parking lot.
